All dogs must be at least 15 months old and be actively training for agility or have competed in agility to participate. Please don't enter an untrained dog thinking it will be fun as it can actually be dangerous for an untrained dog to run. Scores will be time plus faults with the only faults called will be dropped bars and off course. No run-outs or refusals are called. **There will be a SEPARATE REGISTRATION FORM that will be available on the BCCA website by August 3rd. If you don't have a team, we will be HAPPY to help you find a team, if needed. Dogs may only register for one team and each team must have 2 dogs with 2 different handlers.**

Do you have a retired agility Beardie? Think about entering your dog in the Glory Run (no fee). The retired dogs will run the relay course (or a portion of the course) first and go one at a time. Jumps at low height or no bars on request. **There will be a SEPARATE REGISTRATION FORM available on the BCCA website by August 3, 2026.**

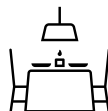

must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not
limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. Overnight entries may not be accepted unless left
without signature required. Overnight entries requiring a signature of recipient may be
returned. Receipt of entry will be emailed to those providing a legible email address.
Confirmation letters and judging schedule will be sent out as soon as possible after closing
of the trial.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to the Trial
Secretary that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Thus, this
change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with the entry
form.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, Official Jump Height card or
Temporary Jump Height Form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a
measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured PRIOR
to running.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without dogs, prior to the start of each class before or after the Judge's briefing. There will be no equipment familiarization for Novice. No training or corrections on the grounds will be allowed. A WARM UP jump area consisting of one regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. This is not to be used for training.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Agility trial is open to Bearded Collies 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC, ILP/PAL numbers or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go 0.8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ▶ No entry shall be made and no entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- ▶ **Bitches in season** will not be allowed in the agility show area of the show grounds. A total refund for bitches in season will be given. A certification from a licensed Vet on their official letterhead must be received by 8 AM day of the trial.
- ▶ **Injured dogs:** Any exhibitor with an injured dog that is unable to run on the Trial date will be refunded with a certification from a licensed Vet on their official letterhead. Certification must be received by 8 AM on the day of the trial.
- ▶ Make checks and money orders payable to BCCA INC in U.S. funds. BCCA is not responsible for cash sent in mail. Post-dated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- ▶ **There will be a \$25.00 service fee for returned checks**
- ▶ Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with a confirmation and judging program. BCCA may decline any entries and may remove any dog because of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against BCCA, or any official thereof or any persons assisting with this show.
- ▶ Errors on entry forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms whosoever may make such errors, and no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of such entries after the closing date.
- ▶ *Please type or print carefully the information on the entry form to eliminate errors.*
- ▶ Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Agility Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance, or other act beyond the control of the Agility Show Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- ▶ Dogs must be ready for judging. BCCA will not be responsible, nor is it obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. *Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class.* Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Conflicts will be handled on an individual basis. The judge will not hold up any class judging or wait for any dog that is in conflict with their agility ring time!
- ▶ All dogs must be held on leash or confined except when being judged and when in the warm up area. The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dog is familiar with & able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under the age of 4 months are strictly prohibited from the show site.
- ▶ Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.
- ▶ NO alcoholic beverages on premises.
- ▶ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Bearded Collie Club of America, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for these events.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple jump Heights within the Same Day Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular or both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host Club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.

Tuesday move ups during the trial may be made as long as the request is received by the Trial Secretary ONLY, at least 30 minutes after the end of Monday's trial.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. **Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
