CRUFTS QUALIFYING

Winners of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Bitch, the Awards of Merit, and Best Bred by Exhibitor are qualified to enter the 2026 and 2027 Crufts Dog Show.

AWARDS OF MERIT (AOM)

The specialty club will offer a minimum of 5 AOMs or 10% of the eligible entry, whichever is greater. See the table below for a guide.

To calculate the total Awards of Merit, **include**:

- All Best of Breed entered (special males & special bitches)
- All dogs & bitches entered in non-regular classes that are eligible to compete for Best of Breed

BEST PUPPY

First place winners from dog and bitch classes for 6 mos. to under 9 mos puppy, 9 mos. to under 12 mos puppy, and Bred by Exhibitor Puppy will be eligible to compete for Best Puppy after Best of Breed. Class winners will be judged together.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR

After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred By Exhibitor Dog and Bred By Exhibitor Bitch classes compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from the Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically awarded Best Bred by Exhibitor.

BEST VETERAN DOG & BEST VETERAN BITCH

First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch after Best of Breed.

RESERVE THREE POINT MAJOR

Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided the criteria set forth in *Chapter 16, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows* is met.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entry

Veteran Classes: For dogs and bitches seven years of age and older. In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, veteran dogs and bitches may be spayed or neutered at specialty shows. All winners of Veteran Classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch after Best of Breed.

Veteran Classes - (Same classes for Bitches)

Veteran Dog (7-under 10 yrs)

Veteran Dog (10-under 12 yrs)

Veteran Dog (12-under 14 yrs)

Veteran Dog (14+ yrs)

Performance: For dogs and bitches, 6 months of age and over, that have earned at least one title in any AKC Companion or Performance Event (Agility, Herding, Obedience, Rally, Scent Work or Tracking). Dogs entered in these classes must not have been neutered or spayed. By virtue of winning these classes, the dog and bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other class.

Performance: (Same classes for Bitches)

Performance Dog

Sexually Altered Class: For dogs and bitches, six months of age or over that have been neutered or spayed. The dog and bitch winning these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Sexually Altered: (Same classes for Bitches)

Sexually Altered Dog

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won any of these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or, if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition. But, **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular conformation classes or Best of Breed Competition. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as a part of another unit. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog Class except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."

Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BRACE CLASS – Each Brace shall be composed of two (2) Bearded Collies with at least one common owner, to be shown in the ring at the same time. The dogs comprising a brace must be named at the time of entry. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace that is already entered in a regular conformation class or Best of Breed **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class."

Entrants must be entered in another class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements, according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (cont.)

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

PEE WEE

DAY OF ENTRY: CASH ONLY

FORMS AVAILABLE FROM DEBBY FURLOW OR PAT COLOMBO

RULES: The AKC Pee Wee Special Attraction is a non-competitive mentoring class for children ages 5 to 9. The focus is entirely on safety, fun, and learning. Handlers must be accompanied in the ring by an adult safety lead, and dogs must be at least 6 months old and well-behaved

Age: Handlers must be at least 5 years old but under 9 years old on the day of the event.

Adult Escort: The child must be accompanied by an adult. Clubs often utilize a secondary safety lead attached to the dog and held by the adult for maximum control.

Dog Eligibility: The dog must be at least 6 months old and AKC-registered (or eligible via PAL/Canine Partners). Spayed and neutered dogs are welcome, but females in season cannot compete.

ITTY BITTY

SPECIAL ATTRACTION: For children under 5 years old! Bring your favorite stuffed or toy dog and join us in the ring for a fun, non-competitive introduction to dog shows. Every participant is a winner in this special attraction designed for our youngest dog lovers.

Stewards of Children - Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

4 - 6 Months Beginner Puppy

Dogs & Bitches will be judged together

Entry Requirements:

The Four to Six Month Puppy competition shall be for the Bearded Collies that are four months of age & over but under six months on the day of the competition.

AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entry.

All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates. For additional information on entry and eligibility requirements, please see the Sanctioned Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition Regulations available on the AKC website at:

SWEEPSTAKES

This Sweepstakes is open to all Bearded Collies who, on the day of the show, will be at least six (6) months of age and under 20 months of age. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes **must** also be entered in one of the regular classes. Champions of Record may be entered in Sweepstakes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and Age Division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes".

Classes: (Same classes for Bitches)

Puppy Dog 6 Mos. & Under 9 Mos.

Puppy Dog 12 Mos. & Under 16 Mos

Puppy Dog 9 Mos. & Under 12 Mos.

Division of Cash Prizes: Cash Prizes after 50% of entry fees in the Sweepstakes has been deducted for club expenses, the remaining 50% of entry fees will be divided as follows:

Classes with 4 or more entries: 1st-40% • 2nd-30% • 3rd-20% • 4th-10%

Classes with 3 entries: 1st-50% • 2nd-30% • 3rd-20%

Classes with 2 entries: 1st-60% • 2nd-40%

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Bearded Collies who, on the day of the show, will be at least seven (7) years of age or older. Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and Age Division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes". Spayed or neutered dogs are eligible.

Classes: (Same classes for Bitches)

Veteran Dog 7 Yrs & Under 10 Yrs

Veteran Dog 12 Yrs & Under 14 Yrs

Veteran Dog 10 Yrs & Under 12 Yrs

Veteran Dog 14 Yrs & Older

Division of Cash Prizes: Cash Prizes after 50% of entry fees in the Sweepstakes has been deducted for club expenses, the remaining 50% of entry fees will be divided as follows:

Classes with 4 or more entries: 1st-40% • 2nd-30% • 3rd-20% • 4th-10%

Classes with 3 entries: 1st-50% • 2nd-30% • 3rd-20%

Classes with 2 entries: 1st-60% • 2nd-40%

Classes with 1 entry: 1st-100%

OBEDIENCE AND RALLY

Include Jump Height on Entry Form for Classes Requiring Jumps. Judging will be in ascending height order beginning at 4". "Dog" refers to either sex. Qualifying Score required for all awards in Regular and/or Optional Titling classes. A refund will be given to any exhibitor who has a bitch entered in the obedience trial or rally trial that comes into season after the close of entries. To receive a refund, the show secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in each trial. RALLY TRIAL - Ring size will be at least 40' x 50'.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASSES

Regular Classes: Novice A, Novice B, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B

Preferred Titling Classes: Preferred Novice, Preferred Open, Preferred Utility

Optional Titling Classes: Beginner Novice A, Beginner Novice B, Versatility

Non-Regular Classes: Veteran, Novice Brace*

Veterans Class: The Veterans class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice class. Dogs may be entered in another class or classes.

RALLY TRIAL CLASSES

Regular Classes: Novice A / B, Intermediate, Advanced A / B, Excellent A / B, Master, Choice

Non-Regular Class: Pairs Novice*

Rally Pairs class consists of competition by one handler working two dogs at one time through a rally course at a level selected and offered by the event-giving club. Scores will be based on a possible 200 points, with ties being broken by time.

TRANSFER POLICY FOR THE SPECIALTY AND TRIALS

The Club will permit a transfer to the next level class in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a Transfer must be made in writing and presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the specified event, show or trial. Transfer forms will be available at the Show Secretary's Table

On-Line entries must be received by the closing hour and date.

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.

NO CRATE SHARING. All dogs must have their own crates.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$4.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$4.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$4.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$4.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.

No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or the Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. A \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from the same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.

REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Club may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. **Note:** No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.

Online entries will receive an **email confirmation of entry received** immediately after submission of entries. **Mailed in** entries will receive email of entry confirmation once entered by Superintendent. Entries acknowledgement with arm band number will be sent **after** entries close. Entry acknowledgment will be emailed to the email address on entry. Judging programs will be posted on the Dog Show In A Box website (www.dogshowinabox.coffeecup.com). Should Exhibitor **NOT** receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, **PLEASE** notify Claudia Sharp at dogshowinabox@gmail.com.

Entry fees shall **NOT** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877- 252-3229. • Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
